SIGNS OF ILL HEALTH

It is important to seek veterinary advice if you suspect that your donkey is unwell. Check your donkey daily for signs of illness. Signs of ill health are often very subtle in donkeys.

Swellings on the body, particularly jaw and neck area



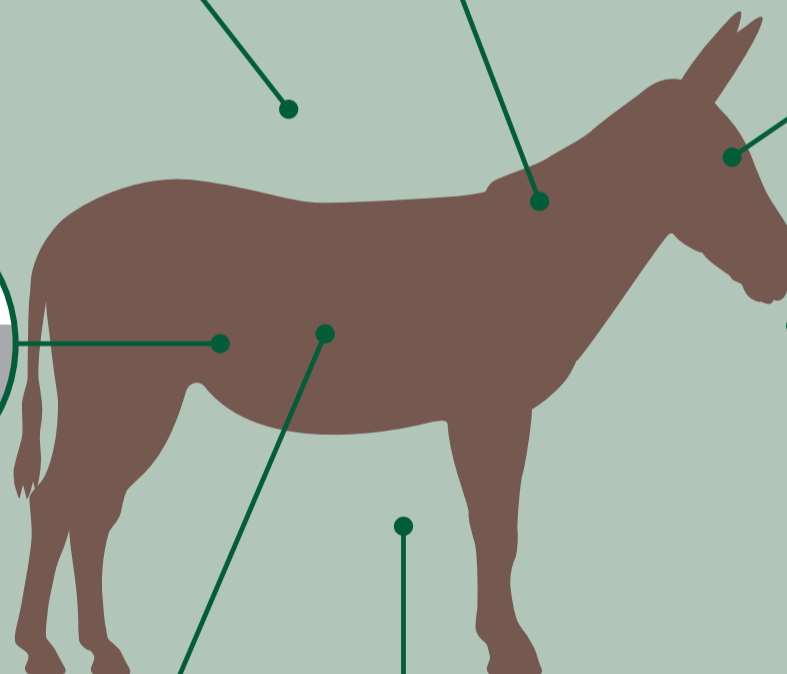
Eating or drinking less



Thick discharge from eyes or nose



Patchy hair loss/sores



Changes in behaviour/dullness

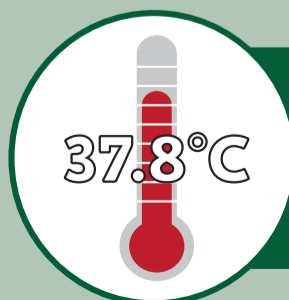


Coughing or changes in breathing



The respiration rate for a healthy donkey ranges from 12 to 28 breaths per minute, with an average of 20 breaths per minute.
